



Rink Rules – Public Skating Policies Public Skating Ages 5 and up

Participants and skaters assume all risks and danger of personal injury arising from or related in any way to admission to the NorthStar Ice Sports Facility including specifically (but not exclusively) the danger of being injured by ice skates, hockey pucks and sticks, other spectators or ice skaters, or by thrown objects. The Holder of the ticket agrees that the NorthStar Ice Sports, Northborough Youth Hockey Program, Inc., and its employees are expressly released by the ticket holder for claims arising from such causes. The ticket holder further agrees to abide by the policies of the NorthStar Ice Sports and the instructions of its employees. By purchase of this ticket, the holder consents to the use of his/her image, without payment of consideration, in any advertising or promotional publicity for the NorthStar Ice Sports and its affiliated programs.

Rink Rules

- All Skaters must purchase a public session ticket
- All skaters must have their hand stamped prior to entering the ice surface
- Patrons **MUST** wear skates when on the ICE
- Helmets are strongly recommended for all participants
- No running, horseplay, tag, chasing allowed
- Roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through skaters is prohibited
- No stick or puck play (ball) allowed
- No food or beverages allowed on the ice at anytime
- Skates are not allowed upstairs in the bleacher area
- No more than two people may skate together
- Skaters are **NOT** allowed to carry children or secondary items such as Cameras, Handbags, etc while skating
- Patrons must **NOT** sit on, lean over, or leave articles on the dasher boards
- For skater's protection, **NO** headphones allowed
- All exits are to be kept clear at all times
- No dogs or pets of any kind are permitted on the premises
- No one is allowed on the ice during resurfacing.
- Zamboni Doors **MUST BE CLOSED** during resurfacing
- Throwing snowballs or any objects is strictly prohibited
- Figure Skating (jumps and spins) are not allowed on public sessions
- Incidents or malicious destruction are to be reported immediately
- Please report any rule violation to a skate guard or rink personnel
- **PLEASE LEAVE ICE PROMPTLY WHEN SESSION IS OVER**
